 - Baystate merch store is currently open. Orders to be delivered to Baystate

- Panache Candy Bars: Hilliard's candy bars to be sold during month of November
- Chipotle: Scheduled for 12/5 in Mansfield. We will earn 33% off orders
- Bedazzled: Looking for dates to hold. Possibly 11/7 (preferred) or 11/14? Will be from 5-7 PM. Store allows for serving alcohol and snacks. We can also have music if desired.

 - Baystate meeting this Monday from 6-7 PM.
 - Will need volunteers!
- EMS Show Choir (Image)
 - On hold until choral teacher hired. Mr. B has asked students for patience while filling role.
 - Panache students excited to potentially have workshops with Image students

Other Updates:

- Mr. Benson is close to hiring an EMS choral teacher
- Successful Bridgewater State University event where students got to play with college kids
- Holiday Craft Fair on 12/10 from 8 AM – 2 PM.
 - Only 10-15 more spots
 - Might hire a food truck
 - Will need volunteer help with setup/cleanup
- Easton Holiday Festival on 12/4. Multiple music groups to perform.
